College Student Volunteer is anyone who is 18 years or older, and currently attending an accredited college or a university.

The requirements to become a College Student Volunteer at South Miami Hospital are:

- Be able to speak and read basic English
- Complete and submit an application
- Schedule an interview with South Miami Hospital Volunteer Services
- Attend an orientation session
- Be tested for tuberculosis
- Provide two reference letters
- Consent to a background check
- Complete a self study
- Commit to work a minimum of 3 to 4 consecutive hours per week (morning shift is from 9:00 to 1 PM, afternoon shift is from 12:30 to 4:30), always on the same day and time
- Work a minimum of 50 hours

Please note that we will only be able to provide certification of your volunteer service hours if you complete the minimum requirements. The MDC students who need to fulfill volunteer hours for Service Learning must apply early in the semester in order to complete 50 hours of volunteer services by their deadline.

Have in mind that most of our volunteer openings are on weekdays, mornings and afternoons. In the evenings and on weekends there are fewer positions available.

If you will stay in Miami throughout the summer, between May and August, and are interested in volunteer during this time, please write "SUMMER PROGRAM" on the field "Skills & Interests" of your application.
