## TEEN VOLUNTEER

Our **Teen Volunteer Summer Program** runs between the months of June and August. Teen Volunteers are High School students between 15 and 18 years old of age.

The requirements to become a Teen Volunteer at South Miami Hospital are:

- Be able to speak and read basic English
- Complete and submit an application
- Permission signed by a parent or legal guardian
- Schedule an interview with South Miami Hospital Volunteer Services
- Attend an orientation session
- Tuberculosis skin test result
- One reference letter
- Copy of immunization records
- Complete a self study
- Commit to work at least 6 weeks, for a minimum of 3 to 4 consecutive hours per week, always on the same day and time
- Sign in and out on your card every time you come to work
- Inform our department when it's your last day, and return the ID badge

Please note that we will only be able to provide certification of your volunteer service hours if you complete the requirements.

Our **After School Volunteer Program** starts in September and runs throughout the school year. The volunteers participating in this program are High School students between 15 and 18 years old.

The requirements are basically the same, and the volunteers commit to work once a week, after school, for 3 consecutive hours, always on the same day and time

It's important to be aware that the volunteer opportunities for this particular program are very limited, and the positions will be filled on a first come first serve basis.
